

Treasurer's Report and Stewardship Report for May (Linda Mueller): Linda reviewed the reports.

Total Income: \$7,551.Total expense: \$10,431.Net Income: -\$2,880.Building Improvement Fund: \$31,030.Parsonage Fund: \$26,962.General Fund: -\$7,431.Memorial Fund Savings Account: \$70,888.Other assets: 573 shares Heartland Financial: \$27,504.Stewardship Report Weekly Giving total: \$7,398.

- Heating and cooling maintenance costs will be estimated this month.
- Jeremy Hylen is looking into the question of the large increase in monthly cost for elevator maintenance.

Head Trustee Report (Mason White):

- Windows in family room not opening.
- Focusing on some landscaping.
- John Brown will look further into lighting the outdoor cross on the church building west side, including costs to fix the light on the flag.

Board of Christian Education Report (Jaymz Stempihar):

- Movie and Cream night on August 2 from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. (Kids drop off)
- Discussion on teachers and rooms for the coming year.

Pastor's Report (Jeremy Hylen):

- Laurie Hylen painted the garage for the cost of the materials only.
- Laurie Hylen will be painting the sanctuary, community room, and family room for the cost of the materials only, donating her time.
- A key cabinet will be purchased and church keys organized by Jeremy.
- Jeremy will cost out and procure a portable air conditioner for the family worship room.
- The carpet in the sanctuary (and other areas where needed) needs cleaning. A carpet cleaning service will complete a test area and quote the remaining surface area per Jeremy.
- A communion table is being donated in memory of Ivy Endres.
- St Paul's UCC has been approved to become a Thrivent Choice donor church providing some donor proceeds via church members who use Thrivent services. They will also be considering financial partnering on future neighborhood projects of the church.
- The congregation will be encouraged in autumn to take advantage of AmazonSmile.
- The American flags were considered after the 4th of July. The outdoor flag is in need of repair, and there is a question how the flags should be displayed. ----
- The electronic sign is being fixed under warranty.
