

Treasurer's Report and Stewardship Report for July (Linda Mueller): Linda reviewed the reports.

Total Income: \$8,164. Total expense: \$8,137. Net Income: \$27. Building Improvement Fund: \$31,572. Parsonage Fund: \$27,805. General Fund: -\$7,604. Memorial Fund Savings Account: \$70,892. Other assets: 573 shares Heartland Financial: \$27,504.

Stewardship Report Weekly Giving total: \$7,785.

Treasurer's Report and Stewardship Report for August (Linda Mueller): Linda reviewed the reports.

Total Income: \$9,600. Total expense: \$9,570. Net Income: \$30. Building Improvement Fund: \$31,723. Parsonage Fund: \$28,648. General Fund: -\$7,482.

Memorial Fund Savings Account: \$69,895, plus Total Memorial Monies: \$757.

Other assets: 573 shares Heartland Financial: \$27,504. Stewardship Report Weekly Giving total: \$8,423.

- Memorial Fund donations received for Iva Endres and Sharon Timm.
- The operating cost for garbage disposal increased by a small amount.

Head Trustee Report (Mason White):

- Plumbing leak in the men's restroom on the lower basement level needs to be repaired.

Board of Christian Education Report (Jaymz Stempihar):

- Trunk or treat on October 28 from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.
- Volunteers needed for Sunday school shepherd program and for nursery.

Pastor's Report (Jeremy Hylen):

- Free Thrivent Choice donor proceeds (via church members who use Thrivent services) available for church projects, such as missions, disaster relief, Sunday school projects, 'Last Supper' drama.
- A key cabinet has been purchased and church keys organized by Jeremy.
- Work in progress on carpet cleaning in the Sanctuary, Gathering Room, Fellowship Hall, and Community Room. Total quote amounts to \$1,300. Much needed cleaning in these areas delayed for a few years.
- The garage light over the garage roof is not working.
- The carpet in the sanctuary chancel area needs to be replaced.
- New wall hangings in the Sanctuary. Old banners to be hung in the downstairs basement level.
- The cost of installing LED lights in the cross on the west exterior amounts to \$2,100.
- What to do with the chairs and pews not used anymore?
- The U.S. flag will continue to be displayed in the church-further discussion is needed.
- A display rack has been moved into the main office and will be used for mail slots. The mail boxes for Treasurer and Head Trustee will remain in the counting room.
- The cabinet in the Music Room is being refinished by Carl Schilling.

President's Report (Richard Reineking):

- Considering doing elevator maintenance less often.
- The recycle pump on the water heater fixed providing hot water in the kitchen sinks plumbing.
- An energy walk through reveals the need to replace burned out bulbs and bulbs emitting insufficient light. LED lights and track lighting suggested for selected areas.

Other Business:

- Working on the signage on the west side of church.
- Hand bell tables moved to the front pew area in the sanctuary.
- New 'thank you' cards made by Joanne Lensink available for use for memorials and other communication.
- Discussion on communication procedures for memorial donations.
- Carillon is broken and not fixable (replaced by digital). Carillon to be discarded but saving the cabinet.
- The Board of Christian Education is buying some folding tables to be used for carnivals and trunk or treat.
- Mike King described a computer programming problem with the church equipment related to screen projection in the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. Motion to purchase a new program passed.
- The two storage areas behind the stage in Fellowship Hall have become congested, and this needs to be fixed.
